The Southend Bach Choir

The Southend Bach Choir began life in 1943 as an evening class of the Municipal College in Southend under the direction of its founder Dr. Harold May, FRCO. Known as the Municipal College Choir, it gave its first performance in December of that year. The programme consisted of selections from Handel's "Messiah".

In its early years, the Municipal College Choir and Orchestral Society sponsored the birth of the College Opera Group, which became independent in 1950. In this year the choir's name converted to Southend-on-Sea Municipal College Choral Society and many challenging concerts followed. At the end of 1963, it became the Southend-on-Sea College of Technology Choral Society! In 1968, still under the baton of Dr. Harold May, the choir became independent as the Southend Bach Choir. In 1993, under the baton of Gerald Bates (Musical Director 1987-2001), the choir celebrated its Golden Jubilee with a memorable performance of Bach's "Mass in B minor". Upon Gerald's retirement in 2001, the choir welcomed Colin Edwards.

In 2023, following the sudden tragic loss of Colin, Roger Humphrey, who had served as our accompanist for 40 years, stepped into the role of Musical Director. Under his direction, the Southend Bach Choir continues to thrive, building on its rich history and looking forward to many more memorable performances.

South East and Central Essex Mind (SECE Mind) will be 60 years old in 2026! Its core functions are supported housing, therapy services and corporate support. The purpose is to help our community and residents, professionals and friends access high quality mental health support in their local area. Our mission for the next 3 years is to Pervent ill mental health in the area, Reduce barriers, stigma and waiting lists, and Promote a positive future for mental health. We did expand SECE Mind's counselling offer across the footprint by focusing on all ages, as well as community groups, e.g. neuro-diverse, Ukrainian and others.
